These drawing and painting sessions include model fees with models holding sustained poses long enough for detailed studies or painting (the 6 sessions are divided into 3 sustained sessions with 2 different models - giving painters or sculptors an opportunity to complete their artwork in studio).

GUATEMALA **JANUARY 2011**

This will be our third adventure to this remarkable country. We keep returning because it is one of the most stunningly beautiful countries we have ever traveled in. Leaving from Guatemala City the group will fly north to the province of El Peten and the town of Las Flores for a visit to the world famous ancient Mayan ruins of Tikal. Our trip concludes back in Antigua for two more sleeps before heading back to Guatemala City and our flight home. All levels of painters and photographers are welcome to join us on this unique tour of one of Latin America's most intriguing destinations

Vietnam & Cambodia

March 2011

Join our 8th International painting excursion to Vietnam and Cambodia as we explore these amazing countries. Our journey begins in Ho Chi Minh City (formally Siagon) teeming with markets, sidewalk cafés, massage and acupuncture clinics, centuries-old pagodas, sleek skyscrapers and ramshackle wooden shops.

From here we travel to central Vietnam to the beautiful central coast town of Hoi An. Here we spend a few relaxing days visiting the ancient merchant houses, Hokkien temple, the majestic 400 year old Japanese covered bridge and the vibrant riverside market. From Hoi An we take a coach north through emerald-green paddy fields and over the spectacular Hai Van Mountain Pass, arriving in the former Imperial capital of Vietnam, the city of Hue.

We continue travelling north to Vietnam's capital Hanoi considered to be the cultural centre of Vietnam. Hanoi has it all; the ancient history, colonial legacy and the modern outlook all jockey for attention amid the surreal urban setting, where every dynasty has left behind their imprint. A short coach ride from Hanoi brings us to Ha Long Bay, a breathtaking Unesco World Heritage Site where we will overnight on a Junk, explore many of the 2,000 limestone islands and rocks which are covered with wildlife and filled with caves and grottoes, as well as visit and paint the many colourful floating villages. Our adventure continues in Cambodia with a tour of Angkor Wat, the largest and undoubtedly the most breath-taking of the monuments which is widely believed to be the largest religious structure in the world. Phnom Penh is our departure point from Cambodia, but not before visiting of some of the capital's most impressive sites, including the National Museum, the Silver Pagoda, the Royal Palace and Phnom Penh's oldest shrine, Wat Phnom.

After 17 wonderful days touring Vietnam and Cambodia I am not sure any of us will want to say goodbye but our departure flight home awaits at Phnom Penhs International airport.
